

Where do I find...

Carrier Identification

Shows trailer license plate number, railcar number, or other carrier or lot identification numbers.

Location of Load

Indicates whether load was unloaded, partly unloaded or loaded.

Temperatures

Shows lowest to highest pulp temperatures recorded for each lot.

Frequency of Defect Occurrence

Percentages show the extent to which each lot was affected by the indicated defect. Checksum line is present to deter alternation of defect percentages.

Grade Statement

Shows whether each lot inspected for grade and condition satisfied the requirements of the specified grade.

Name of Applicant and Shipper

Applicant is the financially interested party that requested the inspection.

Time and Date of Inspection

Date and local time inspector began inspection

Product Identification

For each lot inspected. This area lists product name, container brands or markings, slate or country of origin, and the number of containers in the lot..

Identification of Defects

Briefly identifies, line by line, each defect found in lot, with sample ranges in parenthesis if average of defect exceeds 5%.
