

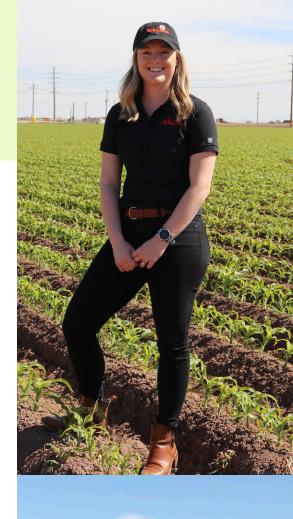
Mission Statement
