COUNTRY–ARGENTINA

Special Note:

Important Notes: Fruit of commodities which are hosts to *Drosophila suzukii* are suspended from the USA (all states) due to detection of *D. suzukii*. Please advise exporters to request an import permit from Argentina if interested in exporting fruit of: *Prunus armenica*, *Prunus avium*, *Prunus domestica*, *Prunus persica*, *Prunus persica* var. *nucipersica*, *Rubus idaeus*, *Rubus ursinus*, *Vaccinium corymbosum*, *Vaccinium angustifolium*, *Actinidia* spp., *Fragaria ananassa*, *Fragaria chiloensis*, and *Fragaria vesca*.

**Fruit destined to Argentina but entering/transiting through Chile
Shipper:**

- Fruit must meet the export requirements of both countries.
- List **both Argentina/Chile** in the block titled "TO: THE PLANT PROTECTION ORGANIZATION(S) OF".
- List Argentina as the country in block 8 (DECLARED NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE CONSIGNEE).
- Write the Additional Declarations for EACH country SEPARATELY (in quotation marks) in the AD box (you may have to use an attachment).

ACOs:

- Scan or fax a copy of the FPC to your ECS as soon as possible so that it can be forwarded to Export Services.
- Export Services will then forward the FPC to the plant protection officials in Chile so as to explain the situation with them to avoid any confusion (re: delays).

COMMODITY – Almonds and Pistachios

BOTANICAL NAME – *Prunus dulcis*, *Prunus amygdalus*, *Pistachia vera*

PRODUCT FORM – Nuts PHYTO FORM – Fed

IMPORT PERMIT - Yes RESTRICTIONS –

Prohibited – in shell almonds and pistachios

Restricted – shelled almonds

SUMMARY INFO -

- **shelled almonds**

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required.

AD Required:

“The shipment is free from TROGODERMA SPP. TROGODERMA GRANARIUM is not known to occur in the United States.”

- **In-shell almonds and pistachios** (Pistachios both Shelled and In-shell)
Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. **DO NOT**

CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.

COMMODITY – Apples and Pears

BOTANICAL NAME – *Malus pumila.* & *Pyrus communis*

PRODUCT FORM – Fruit PHYTO FORM – Fed

IMPORT PERMIT - Yes RESTRICTIONS - Prohibited

SUMMARY INFO – Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. **DO NOT CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.**

County where grown must be recorded on Phyto.

SUBSIDIARY INFO –

Phyto inspections must take place no more than 30 days prior to shipping.

COUNTRY – ARGENTINA

COMMODITY – Apricots, Peaches, Plums, Nectarines

BOTANICAL NAME – *Prunus armeniaca*, *P.persica*, *P.domestica* and *P.persica*
var.nucipersica

PRODUCT FORM – Fruit PHYTO FORM – Fed

IMPORT PERMIT - Yes RESTRICTIONS - Prohibited

SUMMARY INFO - Import permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. **DO NOT CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.**

The California county where fruit was grown must be recorded on the PC. Refer to Import Permit for requirements and Additional Declaration.

COMMODITY – Carrots

BOTANICAL NAME – *Daucus carota*

PRODUCT FORM – Vegetables PHYTO FORM – Fed

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. **DO NOT**

CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.

COMMODITY – Citrus: Lemons, Grapefruit, Mandarins, Oranges

BOTANICAL NAME – *Citrus limon*, *C.paradisi*, *C.reticulata*, and *C.sinensis*.

PRODUCT FORM – Fruit, Plants, Seeds PHYTO FORM – Fed

IMPORT PERMIT - Yes RESTRICTIONS - Prohibited

SUMMARY INFO -

Only lemons are allowed from San Bernardino County.

Import Permit and Federal or State Phytosanitary Certificate Required. **DO NOT**

CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.

SUBSIDIARY INFO -

Phyto inspections must take place no more than 30 days prior to shipping.

COUNTRY – ARGENTINA

COMMODITY – Grapes, Peppers, and other Oriental Fruit Fly host material

BOTANICAL NAME – *Vitis vinifera*, *Capsicum annuum*, and various

PRODUCT FORM – Fruits, Vegetables PHYTO FORM – Fed

IMPORT PERMIT - Yes RESTRICTIONS - Prohibited

SUMMARY INFO -

Fruits and vegetables are prohibited from San Bernardino County. California county where grown must be listed on Phyto Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. **DO NOT**

CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.

SUBSIDIARY INFO –

Phyto inspections must take place no more than 30 days prior to shipping.
