What is the WG Solar Energy Initiative (SEI)?

It is a process WG is utilizing to provide ongoing information about the solar energy industry and also to offer WG members access to information about financial options and solar providers.

The goal of having a vetting process is to introduce WG members to a select group of solar providers.

Is the SEI a referral program?

No, although it is similar to a referral program. Interested WG members will be able to access the contact information of the entities participating in this Initiative. WG members (if they agree) may also be contacted by these participating financial institutions and solar providers.

Participants of this Initiative are required to be WG members and participate in select activities to support WG's overall efforts.
